The project limits extend from the State Route 24/13 Interchange in Alameda County to the State Route 24/Gateway Boulevard Interchange in Contra Costa County.

Project Description:

The Caldecott Tunnel consists of two bores constructed in 1937 and a third bore, north of the original two, built in 1964. The tunnel bores connect Alameda County and Contra Costa County via State Route 24. The Caldecott Improvement Project proposes the construction of a new bore north of the existing bores to relieve congestion and improve safety along State Route 24 in the vicinity of the Caldecott Tunnel. The new tunnel will have two westbound through lanes and one standard and one non-standard shoulder.

This is to advise that the California Department of Transportation has approved the above described project on 10/12/07 and has made the following determinations regarding the above described project:
