Hunter Hill Rest Area in Vallejo has Re-opened

Solano County – The California Department of Transportation, Caltrans, announces that the newly renovated Hunter Hill Safety Roadside Rest Area has now re-opened to the public. The \$3.7 million rest area located on westbound Interstate 80 in Vallejo has been rebuilt to give better accessibility to all travelers.

“Caltrans is committed to providing tired travelers with clean, accessible rest areas along California’s highways,” stated Caltrans District 4 Director Bijan Sartipi. “This newly reconstructed rest area is open again to provide a safe, accessible location for all motorists to stop, rest, and resume their travel as more alert and safer drivers.”

In addition to better accessibility, the new rest area provides an increased number of restrooms and a California Highway Patrol “drop-in” office for enhanced patrol presence in the area. Also, returning to the rest area are the Blue Star Memorial Highway Monument and the topographical panoramic display of Vallejo and the San Francisco Bay Area.
