## Caltrans Announces Full Closure of North and Southbound I-238

**Alameda County** – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) announced full closures for north and southbound Interstate 238 (I-238) between I-880 and I-580. These closures will allow Caltrans to complete final paving and striping on this project.

### Southbound I-238

All lanes of southbound I-238 will be closed between I-880 and I-580 from midnight to 5 a.m. most nights through August 27. In order to facilitate this closure, northbound I-880 to southbound I-238 connector and southbound I-880 to southbound I-238 connector will also be closed.

### Detour Information

Motorists traveling north I-880 will exit at Hesperian Boulevard. Turn right onto Lewelling Boulevard, right onto Mission Boulevard and left onto Mattox Road/Castro Valley Boulevard. Motorists traveling to westbound I-580 should use the on-ramp off Castro Valley Boulevard and motorist traveling to eastbound I-580 will use the Strobridge Avenue on-ramp.

Motorists traveling southbound on I-880 will exit at Lewelling Boulevard; turn left onto Lewelling Boulevard, right onto Mission Boulevard and left on Mattox Road/Castro Valley Boulevard. Motorist traveling to westbound I-580 should use the on-ramp off Castro Valley Boulevard and motorists traveling to eastbound I-580 can use Strobridge Avenue.

### Northbound I-238

All lanes of northbound I-238 will be closed between I-580 and I-880 from 11 p.m. through 4 a.m. most nights through September 2.

## Detour Information

Motorists traveling westbound on I-580 will exit at Strobridge Avenue; turn left onto Castro Valley Boulevard, heading west, make a right onto Mission Boulevard and heading north, turn left onto Lewelling to access I-880.

When completed, I-238 Widening and Rehabilitation Project will reduce traffic congestion, accommodate future traffic growth and improve safety.

Advanced Warning Changeable Message Signs are in place to assist motorists with detours.

Motorists should expect minor delays and proceed with caution through construction work zones. ###
