U.S. 101/State Route 116 Construction
Full Southbound Closure on September 19
New Petaluma Blvd. South Off-Ramp to Open September 22

Petaluma, Sonoma County – Caltrans has scheduled a freeway closure for southbound U.S. 101 and ramp closures for northbound U.S. 101.

Southbound 101 Closure

Southbound U.S. 101 will be closed at the Petaluma River Bridge on Friday night, September 19:

- One southbound lane will be closed from 9 p.m. to 8 a.m.
- All southbound U.S. 101 lanes at the Petaluma River Bridge will be closed **Friday night, September 19, from 11 p.m. to 6 a.m.**
- **One northbound lane on U.S. 101 will be closed from 11:59 p.m. to 8 a.m.**
- **Detour:** Exit at State Route 116/Lakeville Highway and turn left. Continue to State Route 37 and turn right. Continue to southbound U.S. 101. Motorists should expect travel delay and allow extra time to reach their destination.
- **Note:** Petaluma Boulevard South under the Petaluma Bridge will remain open during the southbound U.S. 101 closure.

Northbound U.S. 101 Ramps at Petaluma Boulevard South

The northbound U.S. 101 on-ramp and off-ramp at Petaluma Boulevard South will be closed **Friday night, September 19, from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m.**, and **Sunday night, September 21, from, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.**

- On Monday morning, Caltrans will open a new off-ramp from northbound U.S. 101 to Petaluma Boulevard South.
- The location of the new northbound off-ramp will be about 1000 feet south of the new Kastania overcrossing.
- The existing NB off-ramp will no longer be in service as of Monday morning, September 22.
