U.S. 101 / State Route 116 Construction in Petaluma Caltrans to Close One Westbound Lane on SR 116

Petaluma, Sonoma County – Caltrans has scheduled a long term closure for one lane of westbound State Route 116 at the U.S. 101 interchange. This closure will begin Thursday night, April 25 and will continue until late-2014. This closure is necessary so that work can begin on the bridge structure.

Caltrans has scheduled nightly lane closures on northbound and southbound U.S. 101 from just north of the Sonoma County line to the Kenilworth Pedestrian Overcrossing in Petaluma. In addition, there will be lane closures on eastbound and westbound State Route 116 at the U.S. 101 Interchange in Petaluma. Within the construction zone, at least one lane will remain open in each direction on northbound and southbound U.S. 101, and on eastbound and westbound SR 116.

Previously Announced Construction and Lane Closures

U.S. 101 Closures, County Line to Kenilworth Pedestrian Overcrossing

Northbound U.S. 101: Monday night through Thursday night, from 11 p.m. to 6 a.m., Friday night from 11 p.m. to 6 a.m., and Saturday night from 11 p.m. to 8 a.m.

Southbound U.S. 101: Monday night through Thursday night, from 10 p.m. to 4 a.m., Friday night from 10 p.m. to 7 a.m., and Saturday night from 11 p.m. to 7 a.m.

State Route 116 at the U.S. 101 Interchange

Eastbound SR 116: Monday night through Thursday night, from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., and Friday and Saturday nights, from 10 p.m. to 6 a.m.

Westbound SR 116: Monday night through Thursday night, from 11 p.m. to 5 a.m., Friday and Saturday nights from 11 p.m. to 6 a.m.

This work is weather dependent. If it is delayed due to weather conditions, it will be rescheduled for a later time. Please drive cautiously through the construction zone and
