### DETOURS SCHEDULED ON HIGHWAY 113

**SOLANO COUNTY** – Traffic through State Route 113 in Dixon should expect delays on Thursday, February 19 and Friday, February 20 because of a detour around maintenance work scheduled at the railroad crossing on SR-113 and 1<sup>st</sup> Street.

The maintenance work by the Union Pacific Railroad Company (UPRR) will require a long-term closure of approximately 35 hours at the railroad crossing that straddles the main access through downtown Dixon.

Construction crews will close the crossing at 8 a.m. on February 19 and reopen the roadway to traffic at 5 p.m. on February 20.

For northbound traffic on SR-113 detour around the construction site by:

- Turning right on A Street/E.Dixon Avenue
- Turning left on Pedrick Road, and then
- Heading west on Vaughn Road to NB 113

The detour for southbound 113 traffic is the same in reverse order.

Detour signage will also be in place to aid traffic through the downtown area.
