Highway 12-Jameson Canyon Construction Preparation Intermittent Overnight Lane Closures

Napa and Solano Counties – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans), the Solano Transportation Authority (STA), and the Napa County Transportation and Planning Agency (NCTPA) are preparing to widen Highway 12 through Jameson Canyon in Napa and Solano Counties.

As crews continue to prepare for construction, they must install additional safety barriers and continue with lane striping work which will require some intermittent lane closures and one-way traffic controls starting at midnight Wednesday, May 2nd.

To ensure worker and public safety during the installation, three nights of overnight intermittent lane closures are scheduled to start beginning on Wednesday, May 2nd at 12 a.m. and be completed Saturday, May 5th at 4 a.m. All work is weather permitting.

Lane Closure Times and Locations

During intermittent lane closures, one lane of traffic on Highway 12-Jameson Canyon Road will be closed between Highway 29 and the Napa County Line.

The lane closures will start on Wednesday, May 2nd at 12 a.m. and conclude on Saturday, May 5th at 4 a.m. The closures are scheduled to start at 12 a.m. each morning and conclude each morning at 4 a.m.

The California Highway Patrol (CHP) will help crews direct motorists during the lane closures. Caltrans will also install changeable message signs.

Motorists should allow for extra travel time.
Local access is available for Jameson Canyon residents and emergency vehicles only.
