Closure date confirmed for State Highway 160 Isleton Bridge

Sacramento and Yolo - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) is alerting motorists that the Isleton Bridge on State Highway 160 north of Isleton and south of Courtland will be closed to vehicular traffic for the next 60 days due to maintenance work. Work will begin **Monday, June 25 and last through Friday, August 24**. A scheduling conflict delayed the original closure date by about a week. The work schedule will help lessen the impact to the public school schedules for this area since work will be during the summer recess.

This work is part of an \$8.4 million project to repaint three Sacramento Delta bridges. The Steamboat Slough Bridge south of Courtland was completed last fall on November 15 while the Paintersville Bridge also south of Courtland was re-opened on May 4.

Detour signs are in place. North or southbound motorists travelling on State Highway 160 are advised to plan ahead and factor in additional travel times. Unexpected weather may prolong or cause work to be rescheduled. Caltrans urges motorists to "Slow for the Cone Zone" and "Move Over" if possible. It's the law.
