I-880-23rd/29th AVENUE PROJECT E.8th STREET TEMPORARY CLOSURE BETWEEN LISBON AND PORTWOOD SCHEDULED

OAKLAND, ALAMEDA COUNTY – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will begin backfilling an area surrounding the new retaining wall on E.8th St. between Portwood Ave. and Lisbon Ave., during the second weekend of March 2015. A full lane closure of E.8th St. is essential to perform the work safely. The work will include:

- Structure backfilling behind new retaining wall and roadway section for the new 8th St. HMA paving.
- Residents may notice increased construction lighting and noise as work is being completed. Asphalt and dirt will be used in order to perform the required work.
- May also include Friday night construction work.

Portwood and Lisbon will remain open. Local residence will be allowed to use E.8th St. Caltrans will provide flaggers to direct local traffic in and out of the construction zone. Call (510) 286-6115 if you have questions about the construction progress.

This work is scheduled to begin as listed, but is subject to change due to weather, availability of equipment and/ or materials, and construction related concerns.
