Interstate 80 to Interstate 780 Ramp Connector Work Closures Tomorrow Morning

Vallejo – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) is preparing to install new safety buffers called “attenuators” along the Interstate 80 to Interstate 780 connector lanes in Vallejo tomorrow morning.

Westbound I-80 Connector to I-780 Closure & Detour

To ensure worker and public safety during the prep-work, the westbound I-80 connector lanes to eastbound I-780 will be closed Saturday, April 7th between 7a.m. and 11 a.m.

Motorists headed westbound on I-80 will be detoured onto past the closed I-80/I-780 connector then directed to exit at Magazine Street. At Magazine Street, motorists will turn right on Pine making an immediate right turn onto Magazine going over the overpass. Then right on Lincoln Road East, then right to the eastbound 80 on ramp and onto eastbound I-780.

Eastbound I-780 Connector to I-80 Closure & Detour

As part of the tomorrow’s work, the eastbound I-780 connector lanes to westbound I-80 will also be closed Saturday, April 7th between 7 a.m. and 11 a.m.

Motorists headed eastbound on I-80 will be detoured past the closed I-80/I-780 connector to eastbound I-780 and exit at Glen Cove Road. They will then turn left onto Glen Cove Road going across the overpass and reentering westbound I-780. Motorists will then take westbound I-780 and be directed to the connector lanes onto westbound I-80.

Detour signs will be posted to direct motorists during the closures. Motorists should allow for extra travel time and expect delays.
