I-80 Eastbound Cordelia Truck Scales Relocation Project Overnight Lane Closures on I-80

FAIRFIELD – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) and the Solano Transportation Authority (STA) are preparing to relocate and rebuild the eastbound Cordelia Truck Scales on Interstate 80 in Fairfield.

Starting Monday, April 30th, crews will begin preparing for construction by installing safety barriers and adding temporary traffic striping along eastbound I-80 between the Weigh Station exit and the eastbound Highway 12 and eastbound I-80 interchange.

To ensure worker and public safety during the work, five nights of overnight intermittent lane closures are scheduled to start beginning Monday, April 30th at 10 p.m. and be completed Saturday, May 5th at 6 a.m. All work is weather permitting.

During intermittent lane closures, some of the lanes through the construction area will be closed overnight. Motorists should allow for extra travel time.

Nightly Lane Closure Times

Starting Monday, April 30th at 10 p.m. until Thursday, May 3rd at 5 a.m., intermittent lane closures will begin each at night 10 p.m. and conclude at 5 a.m.

Starting Friday, May 4th at 10 p.m. until Saturday, May 5th at 6 a.m., intermittent lane closures will begin at 10 p.m. and conclude at 6 a.m.

Please drive cautiously through the construction zone and leave a safe traveling distance between your vehicle and the vehicle ahead of you. Caltrans appreciates your patience as we work to improve the highways.
