Interstate 80 in El Cerrito Closed for PG&E Work

The eastbound and westbound directions of Interstate 80 between Carlson Blvd. and Central Avenue in El Cerrito, will be closed for a short time at 6:00 a.m. Sunday morning February 25, 2007. PG&E are installing new power lines across the highway at Huntington Avenue.

Closure Details

Where: I-80 east and west bound between Carlson Blvd. and Central Avenue in El Cerrito.
When: Sunday February 25, 2007 at 6:00 a.m.
How long: PG&E estimate the highway will be closed for up to ten minutes.

CHP will close the highway just north of Carlson Blvd. and just south of Central Avenue. Motorists will have the option of waiting until the road reopens or exiting the highway to go around the closure.

PG&E crews will start preparing to pull the new power lines across the road at 2:00 a.m. Sunday morning, but the highway will only be closed for about ten minutes starting at 6:00 a.m.

Motorists are advised to use extra caution when driving in the area and to "Slow for the Cone Zone".
