Interstate 80 Solano Ramp Metering Project Preps Overnight Ramp Closures Start April 4th

SOLANO COUNTY – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans), the Solano Transportation Agency (STA), and the Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC) will begin installing temporary safety barriers and painting striping overnight on Thursday, April 4th in preparation of the Interstate 80 (I-80) Solano Ramp Metering Project on eastbound and westbound I-80 between Vallejo and the I-505/I-80 interchange in Vacaville.

To ensure worker and public safety, the following ramp closures with detours will be in effect beginning Thursday, April 4th at 8 p.m. and be completed on Saturday, April 13th at 6 a.m. Ramp closures will start each night Monday through Friday at 8 p.m. and conclude the following morning at 6 a.m. All work is weather permitting:

Vallejo, Eastbound Highway 37 Connector to Westbound I-80 Closed

Motorists will be directed to continue eastbound on I-80 and exit at American Canyon Road, then head westbound on American Canyon Road over the overpass, and re-enter westbound I-80 from westbound American Canyon Road.

Vacaville, Westbound I-80 On-Ramp from Alamo Drive Closed

Motorists will be directed to continue southbound on Alamo Drive, then enter eastbound I-80 from Alamo, and exit northbound Davis St., then re-enter westbound I-80 from northbound Davis St.

Vacaville, Eastbound I-80 On-Ramp from Cliffside Drive Closed

Motorists will be directed to southbound on Hume Way, then continue southbound onto Davis Street, then enter eastbound I-80 from southbound Davis Street.

Vacaville, Westbound Interstate 505 Connector to Westbound I-80 Closed

Motorists will be directed to westbound onto East Monte Vista Avenue, then enter westbound I-80 from westbound East Monte Vista Avenue.

Vacaville, Eastbound Interstate 505 Connector to Eastbound I-80 Closed

Motorists will be directed westbound onto East Monte Vista Avenue, then left to eastbound Nut Tree Road Overcrossing, then northbound onto Orange Drive, then enter eastbound I-80 from northbound East Monte Vista Avenue.

I-80 Solano Ramp Metering Project

This week's ramp work is in preparation of the I-80 Solano Ramp Metering Project set to start in mid-April. As part of the project, crews will widen ramps, install ramp meters, and install closed circuit TV cameras at approximately 60 sites along 25-miles of I-80 from Vallejo to Vacaville. The \$12.8 million project is scheduled to be completed in early 2014.

During the ramp closures, the CHP will help direct motorists. Caltrans will also install changeable message signs. Motorists should allow for extra travel time.
