WORK ON STATE ROUTE 84 REQUIRES FULL CLOSURES ON RYER ISLAND

Solano County – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) announces that it has begun a paving rehabilitation project on State Route 84 (SR-84) on Ryer Island. Due to the size of the equipment on this levee road, the construction activities will require a full highway closure north of the Real McCoy ferry and south of State Route 220 (SR-220). Full highway closures will begin the week of August 23 and are expected to continue until Friday, September 3. The full closure will be in effect from 6:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. Residential access will be permitted as construction activities allow.

Motorists will be able to detour around the construction activities by utilizing Ryer Road East and SR-220. Signs will be posted to assist motorists during their travels. The project is expected to be completed in September 2010. Caltrans requests that motorists drive slowly and courteously through the detour. Thank you for your patience.
