Bike Path Closures for Completion of Construction From Shellmound Street in Emeryville to Burma Road in Oakland

Emeryville and Oakland, Alameda County – Starting next week, the bike and pedestrian path from Shellmound Street in Emeryville to Maritime Street in Oakland will be closed from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. so that work on electrical, drainage and signage can be completed. The closure will be Monday to Friday, from September 16th to September 27th. While this section of the path is typically open 24 hours a day, the bike and pedestrian path on the Bay Bridge remains open only from dawn to dusk.

The Burma Road entrance toward the Bay Bridge will also be closed Monday, September 16th, through Wednesday, September 18th, from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m.

Caltrans asks that pedestrians and bicyclists obey traffic signs, avoid areas that have safety cones or safety tape, and in general be alert for construction vehicles and workers.

The California Highway Patrol will be on site to ensure that public safety is maintained. Please remember to Slow for the Cone Zone.
