Pre-Construction Begins for College Avenue Widening Project at U.S. 101

Santa Rosa – Pre-construction is beginning for a widening project on College Avenue at U.S. 101 between Cleveland and Morgan Avenues. For the next month utility companies will be working in the area in order to relocate utility services prior to construction. Construction is currently scheduled to begin on May 19 and will continue into fall of 2014.

This project will widen College Avenue at US 101 between Cleveland Avenue to the west and Morgan Avenues to the east of the interchange. Improvements include new bicycle lanes and pedestrian sidewalks in either direction, a second left-turn lane for eastbound College Avenue approach to the northbound US 101 on-ramp, and an extension of the westbound College Avenue to northbound Cleveland Avenue right-turn lane that will start at Morgan Avenue. New replacement traffic signals within project limits will provide further enhancement to the interchange.

When completed, there will be reduced congestion, improved safety, enhanced pedestrian and bicycle access, and improved traffic flow at the U.S. 101/College Avenue Interchange.
