Paving Repairs on State Route 92 in Half Moon Bay (San Mateo County) One Lane Closed (Eastbound)

San Mateo County- The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will begin work on Thursday, October 16, 2014 to grind and repave the roadway at Post Mile 3.3 to Post Mile 5.1, from Pilarcitos Creek to the Junction of State Route 92 and State Route 35.

The eastbound number 2 lane will be closed from 9:30am to 3:30pm; the work will continue on Friday, October 17, 2014, with the same hours.

NOTE: Paving will not affect traffic into Half Moon Bay.

One lane will remain open to traffic at all times while paving is performed.

Motorists are advised to expect minor delays and to use alternate routes. Please be alert for workers and "Slow for the Cone Zone."
