## Real McCoy II Ferry Out of Service

**Solano County**– The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) has taken the Real McCoy II ferry out of service due to mechanical failure. There is no estimated time of return.

The Real McCoy II, also known as the Cache Slough Ferry, provides regular service on State Route 84 between Ryer Island and the city of Rio Vista in Solano County. The delta region ferry normally runs scheduled crossings every 20 minutes, on the hour, 20 minutes after the hour, and 40 minutes after the hour.

### Real McCoy II Ferry Detour

Motorists are advised to use either the J-Mack Ferry on State Route 220, or the Miner Slough Bridge on State Route 84 to travel between Ryer Island and neighboring communities in Sacramento and Solano Counties.
