San Francisquito Creek Bridge Construction Update (State Route 101) San Mateo/Santa Clara Counties August 4 - 31 (Monday-Friday)

August 4 – 7, Monday – Friday (day work)

Demolition of the West Bayshore Road Bridge started on Tuesday, August 4, and completed on Friday, August 7, during daytime hours. West Bayshore Road sound walls removed along with demolition. New sound walls will be constructed within the next 4 months.

August 10 – 14, Monday – Friday (day work)

Prep work for Pile Driving.

August 17 – 31 Monday – Friday (day work)

Pile Driving will begin on Monday, August 17 at the West Bayshore Road Bridge. Pile driving will take place between the hours of 7:00 AM to 5:00 PM. Flaggers on West Bayshore Road during pile driving hours due to material delivery. This operation will be noisy.

NOTE: Residents may notice increased noise from pile driving equipment and mandatory backup alarms while the contractor is working in the construction zone.

This work is part of the San Francisquito Creek Bridge Replacement project to be completed in the spring of 2018.

Schedule is subject to change due to weather conditions and/or sequencing of work.
