San Mateo County - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will hold a public scoping meeting to present a proposed safety improvement project on State Route 82 at Floribunda Avenue, in the City of Burlingame and Town of Hillsborough. The purpose of the project is to improve safety by reducing the potential for collisions and improve traffic operations.

Caltrans, as owner and operator of State Route 82, has filed a Notice of Preparation with the California State Clearinghouse to prepare an Environmental Impact Report/ Environmental Assessment (EIR/EA).

The scoping meeting will be held to provide the public an opportunity to view the scope of the project and provide comments on potential relevant environmental issues that should be

considered during the preparation of the EIR/EA. Caltrans has identified the following as being potentially affected: Cultural Resources, Biological Resources, Utilities, and Visual/Aesthetics.
