State Route 9 Sight Improvement Project

Santa Clara County— The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) has resumed a project on State Route 9 near Hakone Gardens / downtown Saratoga. This is the third and final location where Caltrans will build retaining walls and upgrade existing lanes and shoulders to improve sight distance for motorists and bicyclists traveling on this highway.

Work being performed Monday through Friday will occur during the daytime from 6:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.; however, some weekend or evening work is possible. A concrete barrier (K-rail) will narrow this section from two to one lane. **Caltrans utilizes one-way traffic control to allow motorists to safely navigate from both directions through one lane that is controlled by an around the clock (24 hrs) signal light.** The project is expected to be completed in late 2015.

Advance warning message signs are in place to assist motorists traveling in the area.

Motorists are advised to use caution when traveling through the area and please "Slow for the Cone Zone."
