Highway 12-Mokelumne River Bridge-Emergency Deck Repair One-Way Traffic Controls

SACRAMENTO and SAN JOAQUIN COUNTIES – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will be doing emergency deck repair work on the Mokelumne River Bridge near the Delta town of Isleton today which will require one-way traffic controls.

To ensure public and worker safety, crews will alternate lane closures in both eastbound and westbound directions. This will allow one lane on the bridge to remain open during the work. Flaggers will help direct traffic. Motorists should expect delays and allow for extra travel time.

Work began at about 9 a.m. Crews hope to have all the lanes reopened by 3 p.m. today. Workers will be working on the metal transitions on the bridge deck.

For boat and ship traffic, the bridge will operate normally for any vessels passing underneath it along the Mokelumne River.

The Mokelumne River Bridge connects Sacramento and San Joaquin Counties and is just east of the Delta towns of Isleton and Rio Vista.

Please drive cautiously through the area and leave a safe traveling distance between your vehicle and the vehicle ahead of you. Caltrans appreciates your patience as we work to maintain our bridges.
