## Highway 1-Tom Lantos Tunnels One-Way Traffic Controls for Week of Monday, June 24th

**SAN MATEO COUNTY** – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will need to perform electrical and miscellaneous paving work along the north and south approach roads of the Highway 1-Tom Lantos Tunnels.

### Monday and Tuesday, June 24<sup>th</sup> to June 25<sup>th</sup>, and also Friday, June 28<sup>th</sup> -Lane Closures Overnight

To ensure worker and public safety, one-way traffic controls will be switching from the northbound bore to the southbound bore throughout the night for the week of June 24<sup>th</sup>, June 25<sup>th</sup>, and June 28<sup>th</sup> at the Highway 1-Tom Lantos Tunnels.

The overnight work is scheduled for **Monday to Tuesday night, June 24<sup>th</sup> to June 25<sup>th</sup>**. The work will start at 7 p.m. nightly and will be completed the following mornings at 7 a.m.

The overnight work is also scheduled for **Friday night, June 28<sup>th</sup>**. The work will start at 9 p.m. and will be completed the following morning at 7 a.m.

During one-way traffic controls, one lane of traffic through one of the tunnels will remain open at all times with flaggers alternating northbound and southbound traffic.

All work is weather permitting. Motorists should allow for extra travel time.
