Highway 1-Tom Lantos Tunnels One-Way Traffic Controls for Week of Monday, June 24th Work Now Scheduled Monday Through Friday

SAN MATEO COUNTY – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will need to perform electrical and miscellaneous paving work along the north and south approach roads of the Highway 1-Tom Lantos Tunnels.

Monday, June 24th to Friday, June 28th -Lane Closures Overnight

To ensure worker and public safety, one-way traffic controls will be switching from the northbound bore to the southbound bore throughout the night for June 24th to June 28th at the Highway 1-Tom Lantos Tunnels.

The overnight work is scheduled for **Monday, June 24th to Thursday, June 27th**. The work will start at 7 p.m. nightly and will be completed the following mornings at 7 a.m.

The overnight work is also scheduled for **Friday night, June 28th**. The work will start at 9 p.m. and will be completed the following morning at 7 a.m.

During one-way traffic controls, one lane of traffic through one of the tunnels will remain open at all times with flaggers alternating northbound and southbound traffic.

All work is weather permitting. Motorists should allow for extra travel time.
