## **Highway 1-Tom Lantos Tunnels One-Way Traffic Controls for Week of Monday, July 8<sup>th</sup>**

**SAN MATEO COUNTY** – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will need to perform miscellaneous paving work and install concrete barriers along the north and south approach roads of the Tom Lantos Tunnels on Highway 1 in San Mateo County.

### **Monday, July 8<sup>th</sup> to Friday, July 12<sup>th</sup> -Lane Closures Overnight**

To ensure worker and public safety, one-way traffic controls will be switching from the northbound bore to the southbound bore throughout the night for July 8<sup>th</sup> to July 12<sup>th</sup> at the Highway 1-Tom Lantos Tunnels.

The overnight work is scheduled for **Monday, July 8<sup>th</sup> to Thursday, July 11<sup>th</sup>**. The work will start at 7 p.m. nightly and will be completed the following mornings at 7 a.m.

The overnight work is also scheduled for **Friday night, July 12<sup>th</sup>**. The work will start at 9 p.m. and will be completed the following morning at 7 a.m.

During one-way traffic controls, one lane of traffic through one of the tunnels will remain open at all times with flaggers alternating northbound and southbound traffic.

All work is weather permitting. Motorists should allow for extra travel time.
