State Route 1-Tom Lantos Tunnels Traffic Shift Beginning Tuesday, November 11

SAN MATEO COUNTY – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will need to perform electrical work in the northbound and southbound Tom Lantos Tunnels on State Route 1 in San Mateo County.

To ensure worker and public safety, beginning Tuesday, November 11, 2014, all northbound and southbound traffic will be shifted onto the shoulder. Northbound construction hours are between the hours of 9:00am to 3:30pm, southbound construction hours are between 7:00am to 3:30pm, Monday through Friday. All traffic will be able to proceed on the shoulder through the tunnel during the work.

NOTE: Cones will be removed at the end of the work day and traffic shifted back to normal lanes.

This work is scheduled until February, 2015.

All work is weather permitting. Motorists should allow for extra travel time.
