State Route 37--Between SR-29 and SR-121 Full Highway Closures-Two Weekends and Five Weekday Nights Starts Friday, September 19, 2014

SOLANO and SONOMA COUNTIES – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) has scheduled major maintenance and paving on State Route 37 (SR 37). This work will require full highway closures for eastbound and westbound SR 37 between SR 29 in Solano County and SR 121 in Sonoma County, starting Friday, September 19, at 10 p.m. All work is weather permitting.

Full Weekend Closures for Eastbound and Westbound SR 37

- Friday, September 19, from 10 p.m. until Monday, September 22 at 5 a.m.
- Friday, September 26, from 10 p.m. until Monday, September 29 at 5 a.m.

Week Night Closures for Eastbound and Westbound SR 37

- Monday night, September 29, through Friday night, October 3, from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m.

Westbound SR 37 Detour: From the SR 37/SR 29 Interchange, take northbound SR-29 to southbound SR -121, and return to SR 37 at the SR 121/SR 37 Interchange.

Eastbound SR-37 Detour: From SR 37/SR 121, take northbound SR 121 to southbound SR 29, and return to eastbound SR 37.

Note: State Route 37 between U.S. 101 and SR 121 will remain open during these scheduled highway closures.
