## Lane Closures on U.S. Route 101 in Palo Alto (San Mateo County) June 8-12

**San Mateo County**-The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will continue construction on the San Francisquito Creek Bridge Replacement Project at the border of San Mateo County and Santa Clara County on U.S. Route 101 in Palo Alto.

To ensure public and worker safety, crews have scheduled the following closures June 8-12, Monday - Friday.

**U.S. Route 101 Northbound:**

Lanes 1 & 2 closed between Embarcadero Road and University Avenue, Monday and Tuesday, June 8 - 9, from 10:00 PM to 5:00 AM

**U.S. Route 101 Southbound:**

Lanes 1 & 2 closed between University Avenue and Embarcadero Road, Wednesday and Thursday, June 10 - 11, from 10:00 PM to 5:00 AM

**U.S. Route 101 Southbound:**

Lanes 1 & 2 closed between University Avenue and Embarcadero Road, Friday, June 12, from 10:00 PM to 8:00 AM.

These closures will allow crews to place k-rail and begin demolition in the median barrier.

Two lanes of traffic will remain open to traffic in both directions during the closures.
