State Route 35 – Removing and Replacing Asphalt (Sand Seal Cover) Post Mile 0.0 to Post Mile 21.0

San Mateo County- The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will begin removing and replacing asphalt and adding a sand seal cover on State Route 35 in and near Palo Alto and Woodside, from the Santa Clara/San Mateo County line to 2.0 miles south of South Junction State Route 92 in the north and southbound directions. This will include various locations.

One way traffic control with flaggers will be in effect Monday through Friday from 7:00 AM to 4:30 PM. One lane will remain open to traffic between construction hours. Construction signs were posted this week to warn motorists of the upcoming project.

A chip seal project was added within the same project limits in 2013.

The sand seal cover will improve the ride of the existing pavement and extend its service life.

NOTE: Residents may notice increased noise from grinding/paving equipment and mandatory backup alarms while the contractor is working in the construction zone.
