U.S. 101 Petaluma River Bridge Construction Project Southbound Freeway Closure Scheduled for Friday Night, March 18

Petaluma, Sonoma County – Weather permitting, on Friday night, March 18, Caltrans will close southbound U.S. Route 101 in Petaluma at State Route (SR) 116. The on-ramp from SR 116 to southbound U.S. Route 101 will also be closed. These closures are necessary to complete a concrete pour and other construction activities at the Petaluma River Bridge.

- Southbound U.S. 101 will be closed at SR 116 in Petaluma from 11 p.m., Friday night, March 18 to 6 a.m. Saturday morning, March 19.
- The Southbound on-ramp from State Route 116 to U.S. Route 101 will be closed from 11 p.m., Friday night, March 18 to 6 a.m. Saturday morning, March 19.
- **Southbound 101 Detour:** exit at State Route 116, turn left on Lakeville Highway and continue to State Route 37. Turn right on SR 37 and continue to U.S. Route 101. This detour will add approximately an additional 20 minutes of travel time.

Please drive cautiously through the construction zone, leave a safe traveling distance between your vehicle and the vehicle ahead of you, and Slow for the Cone Zone. The California Highway Patrol will be on site during closures.
