Ramp Closures on Interstate 880 Allow Emergency Repairs

Alameda County – On Friday, September 18 Caltrans will close the Fruitvale Avenue and High Street off-ramps, and the 29th Avenue on-ramp on southbound Interstate 880 (I-880) from 1 a.m. to 4 a.m. for emergency repairs to crash sand barrels.

Detour is as follows:

Continue southbound 880 and exit 66th Avenue. Turn left on to 66th Avenue and loop back around to access northbound I-880. Motorists can then exit at High Street or Fruitvale from the northbound direction.

Motorists are advised to expect some delays and are encouraged to take alternate routes if necessary. Motorists are also advised that traffic fines are doubled in construction zones.

Changeable message signs have been placed along I-880 to advise motorists of the time and location of the work being performed.
