## Highway 4 – Antioch, Brentwood, and Oakley No Parking During Nighttime Resurfacing

Night work is about to re-start along a 10 mile stretch of Highway 4 from Antioch to Brentwood. The current phase will take place from Big Break Road in Oakley to Sellers Avenue, just east of the Brentwood city line. To avoid interfering with resurfacing work, parking restrictions will be enforced by CHP.

Motorists are advised not to park on either side of Highway 4 from **Big Break Road to Sellers Avenue from May 22 to August 15, 2007 between the hours of 8:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m. Sunday thru Friday.** Signs are posted along the highway advising motorists of the restriction.

Owners who violate the parking restriction may be subject to a fine and illegally parked vehicles will be towed.

Caltrans appreciates your understanding of the need to strictly enforce parking restrictions. Your cooperation will ensure resurfacing work is completed on schedule.

Please use extra caution when traveling through construction areas and remember to “Slow for the cone zone”.
