Northbound & Southbound State Route 160 Repaving

Sacramento County – Beginning May 19 through May 22 and May 27 through May 28 Caltrans maintenance crews will be repaving and repairing damaged asphalt along SR160 between Brannan Island Park and the intersection of SR 12 and SR 160. One-way traffic control will be in effect with the use of flaggers and a pilot vehicle between the hours of 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. during work hours.

Motorists are advised to expect minor delays and encouraged to take alternate routes if necessary. Motorists are also advised that traffic fines are doubled in construction zones.

Changeable message signs have been placed along SR 160 at Brannan Island State Park and at the intersection of SR 160 and SR 12 to advise motorists of the time and location of the maintenance work being performed.
