Highway 12-Jameson Canyon Safety Improvements Overnight Closures and Detour Scheduled

Napa and Solano Counties – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans), the Solano Transportation Authority (STA), and the Napa County Transportation and Planning Agency (NCTPA) are preparing to widen Highway 12 through Jameson Canyon in Napa and Solano Counties.

As construction approaches, it will be necessary to remove some trees adjacent to the roadway. To ensure worker and public safety during the work, five nights of overnight highway closures are scheduled to start beginning on Tuesday, February 14th at 11 p.m. All work is weather permitting.

Closure Times and Locations

Highway 12-Jameson Canyon Road will be closed in both directions between Highway 29 and Interstate 80. The closures will start on Tuesday, February 14th at 11 p.m. and conclude on Sunday, February 19th at 5 a.m. The closures are scheduled to start at 11p.m. each night and conclude each morning at 5 a.m. Motorists should allow for extra travel time.

Highway 12-Jameson Canyon Detour

During the highway closure, westbound Highway 12 motorists are advised to use southbound Highway 29 to eastbound Highway 37 to eastbound Interstate 80. Eastbound Highway 12 motorists should use westbound Interstate 80 to westbound Highway 37 to northbound Highway 29. Local access is available for Jameson Canyon residents only.

Caltrans will also install changeable message signs to help direct motorists. Please see attached map for more detour information.
