Highway 12-Jameson Canyon Open This Weekend Overnight Closures Resume After President's Day Holiday

Napa and Solano Counties – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans), the Solano Transportation Authority (STA), and the Napa County Transportation and Planning Agency (NCTPA) have completed tree removal work for this week but will resume work starting again next Tuesday. The work is needed as crews prepare to widen Highway 12 through Jameson Canyon in Napa and Solano Counties.

Since this week's work is done, Highway 12 through Jameson Canyon is now scheduled to be open overnight tonight through the long President's Day Weekend.

However, to ensure worker and public safety during next week's work, four additional nights of overnight closures are scheduled. All work is weather permitting.

Closure Times and Locations

Highway 12-Jameson Canyon Road will be closed in both directions between Highway 29 and Interstate 80. The closures will resume on Tuesday, February 21st at 11 p.m. and conclude on Saturday, February 25th at 5 a.m. The closures are scheduled to start at 11p.m. each night and conclude each morning at 5 a.m. Motorists should allow for extra travel time.

Highway 12-Jameson Canyon Detour

During the highway closure, westbound Highway 12 motorists are advised to use southbound Highway 29 to eastbound Highway 37 to eastbound Interstate 80. Eastbound Highway 12 motorists should use westbound Interstate 80 to westbound Highway 37 to northbound Highway 29. Local access is available for Jameson Canyon residents only.

Caltrans will also install changeable message signs to help direct motorists. Please see attached map for more detour information.
