## **DIRECTOR KEMPTON TO CUT RIBBON ON NEW ROUTE 37 FREEWAY PROVIDING TRAFFIC RELIEF FOR SOLANO COUNTY COMMUTERS**

**WHAT:** The California Department of Transportation, Solano County, The Solano Transportation Authority, and the City of Vallejo will host a Ribbon Cutting Ceremony, in celebration of the Route 37 four-lane freeway between the Napa River Bridge and Mini Drive/Diablo Street with a partial Interchange at the junction of Routes 37/29. The project also includes the creation of more than 50-acres of tidal wetlands, an Overcrossing at Sacramento Street, a Class 1 bike path, construction of three sound walls and \$ 5 million in future fresh water mitigation and highway planting projects as part of an overall \$124 million in construction for Highway 37 in Solano County.
