Striping - Napa121 Safety Improvement Project

NAPA COUNTY – Caltrans contractors (North Bay Construction) will begin restriping the north and southbound lanes along State Route 121 between Duhig Road and the Sonoma/Napa County lines on Monday, January 26 through Wednesday, January 28 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. Flaggers will be onsite performing one-way traffic control. The Napa 121 Safety Improvement Project also includes improving curve alignments which allow motorist to see better around sharp curves and widening shoulders along State Route 121 between Duhig Road and the Sonoma/Napa County line. The anticipated project completion date is winter 2009. The work is weather permitting.

Changeable message signs have been placed along State Route 121 to advise motorists of the time and location of the maintenance work being performed. Motorists can expect traffic delays during this operation and are advised to use caution when traveling through the area. Motorists are also advised that traffic fines are doubled in construction zones.
