State Route 24 Slope Protection Project Nighttime and Weekend Work Scheduled between October 10-16

CONTRA COSTA COUNTY – Starting on Saturday October 12, Caltrans will begin grinding, paving, and striping the traffic lanes on eastbound State Route 24 (SR-4), adjacent to the newly constructed Multi-tiered Retaining walls on the slope near Risa Road in the City of Lafayette. Due to the nature of the operations, overnight and weekend work is required and scheduled for Saturday October 10, Monday October 12, Tuesday October 13 and Friday October 16. During work, residents may notice increased noise from construction equipment and mandatory safety back-up alarms.

Construction Details:

- Night work is necessary to allow for shoulder closure and/or lane closure of SR-24.
- The hours of work will be:
 - Saturday October 10 from 7:00 AM to Noon, one lane closed EB.
 - Monday October 12 and Tuesday October 13 from 9:00 PM to 6:00 AM.
 - Friday October 16 from 9:00 PM to Saturday October 17 at 7:00 AM, various lanes closed.
- Work will take place on the surface of SR-24, not on the slope below.

If this work is delayed due to weather conditions, it will be rescheduled for a later time. Please drive cautiously through the construction zone, leave a safe traveling distance between your vehicle and the vehicle ahead of you, and Slow for the Cone Zone.
