Highway 113-Striping and Patching Work Intermittent Lane Closures Between Highway 12 and Dixon

Solano County – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) has begun striping and patching work on Highway 113 between Highway 12 and Dixon. The work started on Tuesday, June 26th and is scheduled to be completed Friday, July 20th. All work is weather permitting. Work will start each day at 7 a.m. and conclude at 5 p.m.

To ensure public and worker safety, one-way traffic controls will be in effect on Highway 113 between Highway 12 and Dixon. Crews will alternate lane closures in both northbound and southbound directions. This will allow one lane on the highway to remain open during the work.

Work is not scheduled on Wednesday, July 4th.

Flaggers and CHP will help direct traffic. Motorists should expect delays and allow for extra travel time.

Please drive cautiously through the construction zone and leave a safe traveling distance between your vehicle and the vehicle ahead of you. Caltrans appreciates your patience as we work to improve the highways.
