### TRAFFIC CONTROL ON STATE ROUTE 12 BETWEEN DROUIN DRIVE AND STATE ROUTE 113

**SOLANO** – In an ongoing effort to improve safety along State Route 12 in Solano County, the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) has scheduled a day of traffic control to enable crews to replace damaged channelizer posts on that route, weather permitting.

Crews will be working on Wednesday, October 12, from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. Work will begin at Drouin Drive in Rio Vista and proceed west to State Route 113. Motorists may expect delays up to 20 minutes as crews stop traffic, replace damaged channelizer posts, and then open lanes to traffic. Approximately 200 channelizer posts in the centerline rumble strip, which have been damaged or knocked down by traffic, will be replaced.

The California Highway Patrol will be on site during the temporary road closures.

Channelizer posts delineate driving lanes with bright colors and help save lives by properly directing traffic and reducing the chance of accidents.

Motorists are advised to use caution when traveling through the area and please "Slow for the Cone Zone."
