State Route 29-Channelization Project-Napa County Updates Starting Sunday, October 4

NAPA COUNTY – Caltrans and its local stakeholders have started construction of the State Route 29 (SR-29) Channelization Project in and near St. Helena in Napa County.

Limited project-related utility work is scheduled for the first two-weeks of October 2015.

Daytime Work-Starting Sunday, October 4

AT&T will remove remaining utility poles and abandoned underground cabling from Zinfandel Avenue to Charter Oak Avenue. Work will be primarily in the southbound shoulder. Hours of work are 8:00 AM until 3:00 PM.

Site maintenance work will also be performed daily by Caltrans contractors from 7:00 AM to 3:30 PM between Mee Lane to Stice Lane. Work includes storm water pollution prevention maintenance and site management. No traffic lane closures are scheduled.

Installation of storm water pollution prevention measures start October 12 in preparation for a re-start of construction work on October 18, 2015. Work will occur from Stice Lane to Charter Oak and will not require any traffic lane closures. No night work is scheduled for this period.
