SR-87 and Alma Street Off-Ramp Drainage System Repairs Scheduled

Santa Clara County—The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will begin work on Wednesday, August 24 to repair and upgrade the drainage system on **southbound SR-87 just south of the Virginia Street overcrossing** in San Jose.

The work is scheduled to be completed in late September 2011 and encompasses both the southbound SR-87 mainline freeway and southbound SR-87 connector ramp to the Alma Avenue exit.

The project will require off-peak lane closures on the southbound SR-87 mainline near the Virginia Street overcrossing and intermittent closures of the southbound SR-87 connector ramp to the Alma Avenue exit.

Lane Closure: One lane closure southbound SR-87 (right-most lane) on Wednesday, August 24 thru Friday, August 26 from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. **Detour:** None required

Ramp Closure: Continuous closure southbound SR-87 connector ramp to the Alma Avenue exit on Friday, August 26, 11:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m. Monday morning, August 29. **Detour:** Take southbound SR-87 and exit left (eastbound) on Curtner Avenue off-ramp to left (northbound) on Monterey Road to Alma Avenue.

Lane and Ramp Closure: Two of three lanes closed on southbound SR-87 and partial connector ramp closure (left lane) on the Alma Avenue connector ramp on Monday, August 29 and Tuesday, August 30 from 11:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m.

Detour: Take southbound SR-87 and exit left (eastbound) on Curtner Avenue off-ramp to left (northbound) on Monterey Road to Alma Avenue.

Advance warning changeable message signs and detour signs are in place to assist motorists traveling in the area.

Motorists are advised to use caution when traveling through the area and please "Slow for the Cone Zone."
