## STORM ROAD INFORMATION BULLETIN

*\* 4:30 p.m. \**

**Oakland** - The earlier heavy storms that impacted Bay Area freeways, highways and bridges are subsiding. Localized flooding and mudslides can still occur anytime and block ramps, lanes and shoulders.

Caltrans crews are monitoring the roads. Motorists are strongly cautioned to drive very carefully if they are on the road as crews may not have reached a particular area yet.

Current road conditions for the Bay Area are:

### Marin

US 101: Northbound and southbound have re-opened.  
Interstate 580: Both directions have re-opened on Richmond-San Rafael Bridge.  
Highway 1: Now open at Stinson Beach to Bolinas turnoff.

### Contra Costa County

Interstate 580: Both directions have re-opened on Richmond-San Rafael Bridge.

### Alameda County

All roads being watched for potential trees and power lines down and mudslides.

### Santa Clara County

Route 9: Southbound lane closed at Pierce Road due to mudslide. One way traffic control.  
Route 9: Closed at 35 due to downed power lines and trees.  
Route 17: Northbound just south of the Summit has re-opened.  
Route 17: Closed southbound at Route 9 due to a mudslide and flooding. Detour is southbound 101 to westbound 129.  
Route 17: Southbound just south of Madrone Road is now open.  
Route 35: Trees blocking lanes one mile north of Route 9. One lane is open.

US 101: Southbound, two right lanes closed at Route 85 due to potholes. No estimated time of opening.

## Solano County

Interstate 80: All lanes now open.

Interstate 505: Southbound closed north of Midway Road due to flooding. No estimated time of opening.

## San Francisco County

US 101: Northbound connector toward Golden Gate Bridge to southbound 1/19<sup>th</sup> Avenue closed due to hole in the roadway. Estimated time of opening is 4 p.m.

## San Mateo County

Route 92: All lanes have re-opened.

## Sonoma County

Highway 1: Closed at Timber Cove due to downed power lines.

Route 12/121: Closed at Schellville due to flooding.

## Napa County

All roads being watched for potential trees and power lines down and mudslides.
