### **Night Paving Work on U.S. 101 from the Junction of S.R. 116 at Cotati to the Cry Creek Exit at Healdsburg, Excluding U.S. 101 Widening Project in Santa Rosa**

**Santa Rosa-** Caltrans is conducting paving work on U.S. 101 from the Junction of State Route 116 at Cotati north to the Dry Creek exit in Healdsburg. Caltrans will not be extending paving operations into the U.S. 101 widening work area in Santa Rosa. Crews will work at night only.

Temporary signs and changeable message signs will alert motorists of the work areas. The California Highway Patrol will be on site to assist, as needed. Orange cones will indicate lane closures. At all times, at least one lane will be available for through traffic in each direction. All ramps will remain open, with the exception of some work at the southbound Arata Lane onramp in Windsor. Dates for that work are yet to be determined.

This work will begin Monday, October 2 and extend through late in October. Crews will begin work north of Santa Rosa. Further details about the schedule will be released, as they become available.

Closure times indicate the night closure time, and the morning opening the following day.
