State Route 238/Mission Blvd. Roadway Rehabilitation Project Paving Continues

FREMONT/UNION CITY –Work continues for the State Route 238/Mission Blvd. Roadway Rehabilitation Project between Interstate 680 in Fremont and Blanche Street in Hayward. All construction activities are weather dependent.

Construction Activities

- Grinding and paving continues at many locations next week, from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Please note that project limits for the following schedule could change, based on the progress made on any given day:
 - Monday, June 20--Grinding/paving the left lane northbound from Appian Way to Whipple Road.
 - Tuesday, June 21--Grinding/paving the right lane northbound from Tamarack Drive to Blanche Street, and then grinding/paving the right lane southbound from Blanche Street to Whipple Road.
 - Wednesday, June 22--Grinding/paving the left lane northbound from Whipple Road to Blanche Street, and then grinding/paving the left lane southbound from Blanche Street to Whipple Road
 - Thursday, June 23--Grinding/paving the left lane southbound from Whipple Road to Decoto Road.
- Caltrans will switch to the new traffic signals at Las Palmas Avenue on Tuesday, June 21. During the switch, there will be stop signs at the intersection of Las Palmas Avenue and Mission Boulevard. Motorists should expect delays during this work.
- Crews will be working throughout the project at other locations. Please be alert for lane closures and construction workers.
