Wanda Street in Crockett Reopens After Year-Long Improvement Project

Crockett - After being closed for just over one year, Wanda Street in Crockett is once again open to traffic.

The dismantling of the original 1927 Carquinez Bridge, particularly the western touchdown structure, gave Caltrans additional space around Wanda Street. Caltrans closed the road in November of 2006 to safely accommodate the dismantling of the structure. Once the structure was gone, the improvement project got underway.

The road was realigned and widened, providing easier truck access to the C&H sugar plant and improved traffic flow. Other improvements include a new bicycle path, improved drainage, and landscaping.

The rest of the \$1.6 million dollar project will finish sometime in the spring of 2008.
