

Alameda State Route 13 Storm Damage Repair Project Factsheet



Project Location

The project is located on the side slope adjacent to State Route 13 near the northbound on-ramp at Moraga Ave. in the Montclair neighborhood of Oakland, Alameda County.

Project Purpose and Need

The purpose of the project is to repair the slope and prevent further slide damage.

Project Description

The project includes constructing earth retaining structures including a ground anchor wall, an anchored diaphragm wall, and a soldier-pile wall. The project also includes repair of damaged pavement, drainage system and re-planting trees and shrubs with natives, in areas where removal is needed.

Project Funding

The total project cost is \$4.1 million from the State Highway Operation and Protection Program (SHOPP).

Begin Tree Removal: Winter 2015

End Construction: Winter 2016
