

Alameda State Route 13 Storm Damage Project Public Meeting Factsheet



Project Location

The project is located on the side slope adjacent to State Route 13 near the northbound on-ramp at Moraga Ave. in Alameda County, Oakland.

Project Purpose and Need

The purpose of the project is to repair the roadway and hillside damaged by storm-related mudslides. These repairs will prevent further slide of the hillside and additional roadway damage.

Project Description

The repairs include constructing earth retaining structures; a ground anchor wall, an anchored diaphragm wall, and a soldier-pile wall and repairing damaged pavement and drainage system. The project also includes re-planting trees and shrubs with natives, in areas where removal is needed.

Project Funding

The total project cost is \$5.3 million from the State Highway Operation and Protection Program (SHOPP).

Project Schedule

Begin Construction: Early 2015

End Construction: Early 2016
