

State Route 35 Near Sky Londa Soldier Pile Wall Project



Fact Sheet

Project Location

The project is located along Route 35, Post Mile 13.1, near Sky Londa, at the north junction of Bear Gulch Road, in San Mateo County.

Project Purpose

The purpose of the project is to repair a storm damage slipout.

Project Scope

The scope of the project includes the construction of a soldier pile wall, as well as the installations of metal beam guardrail and cable railing alongside the soldier pile wall.

Background

Originally scoped to reconstruct the slope with rock slope protection, due to political and community involvement to fast track the slope repair, the project was rescope to construct a soldier pile wall. The rescope was necessary to ensure that the work remains within State right-of-way and avoid encroachment into an environmentally sensitive area. With the rescope of constructing a soldier pile wall, the project was expedited by one fiscal year.
