

STATE ROUTE 82 (EL CAMINO REAL) AT FLORIBUNDA AVENUE INTERSECTION SAFETY IMPROVEMENT PROJECT Fact Sheet

Project Location:

State Route 82 (El Camino Real) at Floribunda Avenue, Post Mile 13.7, in the City of Burlingame and Town of Hillsborough, in San Mateo County.

Project Purpose:

The project will improve safety and reduce the potential for collisions involving vehicles making left turns from both directions of El Camino Real at Floribunda Avenue.

Project Background:

At the intersection of El Camino Real and Floribunda Avenue, El Camino Real is a four-lane undivided highway, with two 11-ft through lanes with uncontrolled left-turn movements in both directions. Due to the actual accident rate at this intersection being greater than the statewide average for collisions involving vehicles making left turns, the project was proposed to improve safety and reduce the potential for left-turn related collisions.

Project Funding:

The project is funded by the State Highway Operation and Protection Program. The project is currently programmed for approximately \$6 million, which covers Construction Capital, Right of Way Capital, and Support Costs.

Status:

Caltrans is the lead agency for this project. The current schedule is as follows:

Design Completion: June 2017
